The LQHBA will once again sponsor a stallion breeding auction to benefit our scholarship program through an *Online Auction* that will close **Friday, January 23, 2026**. The LQHBA stallion auction website is www.lqhbastallionauction.com

The net proceeds received from each donated breeding are awarded to graduating Louisiana high school seniors to help them with the financial expenses of getting started in college. To date, over **\$950,000** has been awarded through this program which began in 2001. *That is certainly a number that we are all extremely proud of!*

Your donation will be auctioned online on our stallion auction website. The LQHBA will auction the breeding along with farm fees and chute fees, if any. All minimum bids will include farm fees and chute fees. **The price you bid is the TOTAL price you will pay if you are the winning bidder. The bid does NOT include the boarding fees related to the care of the mare.**

Every stallion donated will be featured in our online auction with a picture, pedigree information, a link to the website of the farm where the stallion is standing, and if the stallion is listed on www.stallionsearch.com, we will link to the stallion page on that site for additional information. If the farm does not have a website or if the stallion is not listed on [stallionsearch.com](http://www.stallionsearch.com), we will upload information provided by the stallion owner to assist in marketing the stallion.

New bids are updated instantly. We strongly encourage everyone to please visit the LQHBA Stallion Auction website www.lqhbastallionauction.com. **Bidding will begin approximately December 5, 2025.** To donate a breeding, please complete the stallion donation form and return it to the LQHBA office by **Friday, November 14, 2025**.
